

Notice of Rulemaking

The Arkansas Department of Labor & Licensing's Board of Barber Examiners hereby issue the following proposed amendments to its Rules pursuant to its authority under Ark. Code Ann. § 17-20-206.

The Board is updating its existing rules to provide for the criminal background process mandated by Ark. Code Ann. § 17-3-101 *et seq.*; to update rules to provide for Automatic Licensure of Active Duty Service Members, Returning Military Veterans, and Spouses per Ark. Code Ann. § 17-1-106; to update its rules regarding reciprocal licensure as required under Acts 426/1011 of 2019; to change the title from secretary of the board to director per Act 910; and to remove the term "Regulation" per Act 315 of 2019.
